SISD's 2016-17 Ratings

Implementation Process

- Texas Education Code §39.0545 was adopted 4 years ago
- Requires Districts to annually self-evaluate all campuses and the district overall in the area of “community and student engagement”
- Each year, SISD convenes a Local Committee to review the locally developed criteria rubrics for each required area:
 - 1) Fine Arts
 - 2) Wellness & Physical Education
 - 3) Community & Parental Involvement
 - 4) 21st Century Workforce Development
 - 5) Second Language Acquisition Program
 - 6) Digital Learning Environment
 - 7) Dropout Prevention Strategies
 - 8) Educational Programs for Gifted & Talented Students
- ✓ Plus: Compliance with Statutory Reporting and Policy Requirements

Changes This Year

- Beginning with the 2017-18 school year, the Community and Student Engagement self-ratings were going to be included in the A-F Texas public school accountability ratings as part of Domain Five
 - *Each campus and district would be required to pick 3 of the 8 indicators to be computed into Domain 5
- This year, TEA required the PEIMS submission to include the selection of 3 indicators for each campus and the district
- Campus Leadership Teams completed the self-ratings and picked 3 indicators, providing support and documentation for the June 22 PEIMS submission
- HB 22 became law on June 15, 2017 repealing Texas Education Code §39.0545
